FINANCIAL REGULATIONS
(Effective 1st June 2008)

The maximum entry fee and donor fee to be levied and the minimum prizes to be offered by the organizers at all Tamil Nadu State Championships are tabulated below.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS:

1. State Championship Registration fee:

State events will be allocated only on remittance of the Registration Fee mentioned in Column 2. This is non-refundable.

2. State Championship Entry Fees:

Ten percent of ordinary entry fees and 50% of donor entry fees received shall be paid to TNSCA. For FIDE-Rated State Championships this shall be 5% of entry fee and 50% of donor fee.

3. International Open & FIDE-Rated Open and FIDE-Rated State Championship Tournaments:

Organizers of FIDE-Rated Open Tournaments or All India Tournaments shall register their tournaments with us on payment of 20% of what they pay to AICF. At the end of the tournament the organizer shall remit 5% of the entry fee collected.

4. FIDE Rated Closed Event:

Flat fee of Rs.500.

5. State Level or All India Tournaments:

Organizers of State Level Opens and All India Tournaments shall register their tournaments by paying a Registration Fee of Rs 1000. At the end of the tournament the organizer shall remit 10% of the entry fee collected.

6. Player's Registration fee:

Rs.70 per player per year is payable by all players in State-level Open Tournaments and in State Championships. Every player shall sign an application form and shall be issued a registration card. Players could register themselves for 5 years on payment of Rs 250. Life Members of TNSCA are automatically registered for Life.

7. Arbiter's Registration fee & Payment:

Rs.50 per year (or Rs 500 for Life) per Arbiter is payable by all Arbiters in State-level Open Tournaments and in State Championships. Every arbiter shall sign an application form and shall be issued a registration card.

Chief Arbiters shall be paid a minimum of Rs.500 per day and deputy Arbiters Rs.300, plus travel and free hospitality. In Rapid tournaments the fees shall be Rs.750 and Rs.500 per day.

8. Fee from organizers of National Championships in Tamil Nadu:

Organizers of any National Championship in Tamil Nadu shall pay 20% of whatever they pay to the AICF as non-refundable EMD.

9. Annual Membership fees:

District Associations	: Rs.1,000;	Chess Academies	: Rs.2,500;
Special Units	: Rs.2,500;	Corporate Members	: Rs.10,000;
Life Member	: Rs.2,500;(one time payment)		

10. Grants obtained from Government:

When grants are obtained by the TNSCA for staging State or National Championships, the TNSCA shall retain 10% of the grant and pass on 90% to the organizers.

11. Financial support for players:

All players representing Tamil Nadu in official National Championships shall be paid before the event, at least:

- (a) Concessional Second Class Train fare and reservation charges;
- (b) Entry fee;
- (c) food expenses at the rate of Rs.60 per day.
- (d) Officials accompanying the teams shall be paid Rs.75 per day.

12. Dues from members:

Members in any arrears of payment during a financial year must remit their dues before Sep 30th of the next financial year to continue to be entitled to a member's privileges. However, basic membership dues as given in No.9 above must be paid latest by 30th June.
