Rules and Regulations:

Rule: FIDE Rules in force shall apply.

System of Play: Tournament shall be conducted on an 11 Rounds Swiss system.

Time Control: 90 minutes each with 30 seconds increment per move from move no 1,
Mechanical Clocks Two hours each straight finish.

Age Limit: Players must have been born on or after **01-01-2003**. Age proof is required. Complaints against suspected over aged players could be made on payment of Rs.1000/- to the Organizers, who shall medically verify the players concerned.

**** Note to District Chess Associations: As per the rules of AICF only the players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their births are permitted to take part in respective age group nationals. Hence District Associations are directed hereby to forward the names of players whose birth registrations have been done within a year of their births for this TN State U-9 Championship. Wherever discrepancies exist the matter may be taken up with AICF through TNSCA. This will avoid the inconvenience caused to such players when they appear in National U-9 Championship.**

Registration of participants with TNSCA is compulsory. The participants of all TN State Chess Championships are required to register themselves with TNSCA by paying Rs.70/- as registration fee. For the year 2011-12, the players have to remit Rs 70/- along with the duly signed TN players Registration form.

Entry Fee: Boys & Girls -Normal: Rs 250/-, Donor –Boys: Rs. 450/- & Girls: Rs. 400/-

All entries, be it donor or regular, should be sent through the respective District Chess Associations with a copy to Tamil Nadu State Chess Association on or before 30-01-2012.

Late entries will be permitted on payment of a late fee of Rs.200/- per player till 31-01-2012.

Subject to age limit, the following players are eligible:

1. Every affiliated member of TNSCA is entitled to send two entries in each category.
2. Every recognized academy of TNSCA can field one entry in each category.
3. The top four rankers of the 24th TN State U-7 Boys and Girls Chess Championship held at Trichy are seeded to play in this event. Boys: 1. Aditya M (Che), 2. Bragadeesswaran C (Che), 3. Akilesh Viswaa (Try), 4. Ashwin Kumar B S (Mdu).
Girls: 1. Samyuktha B S (Vel), 2. Rithikaa K (Try), 3. Rindhiya V (Tlr), 4. Poornasri M K (Tlr).
4. The top four rankers of the 24th TN state U 9 Boys and Girls Chess Championship held at Chennai are seeded to play in this event. Boys: NIL. Girls: Lakshmi C
5. The top two rankers of the 24th TN state U 9 Chess Championship for girls can opt to play in Boys category. NIL.

6. Any player who donates the prescribed donor fee: U-9 Boys Rs.450/-, Girls Rs. 400/-
7. In each category the host Krishnagiri District chess Association is entitled to field one additional entry.
8. In the event the total number of entries is an odd number Krishnagiri district chess association is also entitled to add one more player to make the total number even in each category
9. Those who have qualified to represent the country in official FIDE events.
10. In addition to the above the following districts can field additional entries by virtue of their players finishing in top four of the previous 24th TN State U-9 Chess Championship held at Chennai. Under 9 Boys: ERO-1; CHE-3; Girls: CHE-3; CBE-1;
11. Two players in each category from where no district association exists.

A copy of the entry should be sent to TNSCA.

Lodging: Free dormitory type of lodging will be given to players plus a manager per team at college hostel.

**** Note: While sending the entries District Chess association should certify that their players have been selected from the selection/district Chess Championship .If such a certificate is not sent all their entries will be treated as donor entries.**

Tie break: Buchholz tie break rules will be applied. In case of tie, Prizes will not be shared.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing chief arbiter in writing.

Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the tournament a five member appeals Committee will be formed at the managers meeting. The decision of the appeals committee on all protests shall be final and binding.

Chess Clocks: Each association is requested to provide at least two chess clocks.

Protests: Protests, if any against the decision of the arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee Rs.200/- within 30 minutes of the incident. The protest fee is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

Arrears: The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to TNSCA, will not be allowed to take part in the above event.

The organizer Krishnagiri DCA /TNSCA reserve the right to admit/reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof.

The organizer Krishnagiri DCA /TNSCA reserve the rights of admission to the tournament venue and lodging places.

Silence in the Tournament Hall:

Strict silence must be observed in the tournament hall. Spectators, and the players who have finished their games, shall not remain in the tournament hall. Players shall not

analyze in the tournament hall.
